PROSPECTUS BACHELOR IN MITHILA FOLK PAINTING ADMISSION TEST 2024-2027

Objective

To get excellence in their respective field by the students of Mithila Folk Painting and to get certain objectives of their creativity by stimulating their inner expressions. All information shall be provided about the medium/ subjects used in Mithila Folk Painting from the ancient period to the present day with the objective to make this programme could play a role for being traditional, individual, social and also the job oriented.

Eligibility

A candidate seeking admission to BMFP Programme must satisfy the following conditions.

- He/She must be an Intermediate/+2 level as a regular student or as a student of distance education.
- Maximum age for admission in this course shall be 37 years.

Duration of Programme

The Bachelor in Mithila Folk Painting (BMFP) programme shall be of Three years duration. An academic year is divided into two semesters. In each semester, courses are offered in 15 teaching weeks and the remaining 5 weeks are to be utilized for conduct of examinations and evaluation purposes. Each week has at least 30 working hours spread over 6 days a week.

A candidate of the BMFP Programme shall undergo a regular course of study for Three Academic Years, that is, Six Semesters. Semester-I shall be from July to December and Semester-II shall be from January to May. There shall not be less than 90 working days, which shall comprise not less than 450 teaching/working hours for each semester. (Exclusive of the days for the conduct of CIA or external/ end-semester examinations).

Admission

Admission will be taken in the month of July in each Academic Year as per university norms.

The candidates shall have to appear in written test (objective type) of 40 marks and practical test (painting) of 50 marks for getting selected for this programme. 10 marks shall be provided to the candidates having Certificate Course in Mithila Folk Painting or awarded in Madhubani Painting.

Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit which shall be prepared according to the marks obtained by the candidate in the test.

A candidate must have a fitness certificate from a registered medical practitioner.

A candidate should have communicable vocabulary, and should have the ability to read and write correctly in Hindi or English.

Entrance Test fee shall be charged from the candidates. The amount of the test fee would be decided by University.

Entrance test will be conducted by University. Seat allotment will be done through counseling.

Reservation of seats for the candidate of reserved category shall be given as per Govt. rules. A Certificate will be compulsory for such candidate, issued from a competent Government officer. If reserve category seat remains vacant then it will be allotted to general category candidate.

If at any time it is found that the candidate has furnished any false information, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately and the deposited fee shall be forfeited and suitable legal action may be initiated.

In case of any controversy or irregularity pertaining to BMFP, the University (Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna) shall take the final decision as per approved Rules and Regulations

The University reserves the right to cancel the admission of any student at any stage of his study at the University on grounds of unsatisfactory academic performance, irregular and insufficient attendance or indiscipline.

Course Fee Structure

The Registration and Examination fee shall be decided by the University from time-to-time.



At the time of admission, the student is required to provide the following documents in original:

- Matric/ICSE/CBSE/NIOS/Other Board Certificate.
- Pass Certificate of the qualifying examination - +2 or Intermediate.
- Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination – +2 or Intermediate.
- College/School Leaving Certificate (CLC/SLC).
- Character Certificate of +2 or Intermediate.
- Migration Certificate (Not necessary for those from Bihar Board).
- Caste Certificate (from DM or competent authority for SC/ST/OBC/EBC/Differently Abled)

Total Number of Students

There shall be basic unit of 30 students, with a maximum of two units. This intake capacity may be modified by the University (Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna).

Registration

All students must register themselves at the University within the fixed date notified by the University in the first semester itself.

Programme Structure

All subjects will have Lecture-Tutorial-Practical (L-T-P) components to indicate the contact hours and will have a credit count. Teaching of subjects will be reckoned in terms of credits.

The curriculum for BMFP programme shall include a "Project Work/ Group Work/ Study Tour & Project Presentation" in 3rd, 4th & 5th semester. The experience may be obtained in any reputed company/organization belonging to any industry, or any organization of comparable repute. The place of work has to get prior approval of the Institute. On completion of the project, the student shall submit a report to the department. The report of Project Work/ Group Work, etc. shall be followed by the viva-voce examination. If there is a serious difficulty in finding placements for project work, writing a Term Paper with empirical data can be considered under a competent faculty. This will be at the discretion of the Institute Authority.

Examinations

There shall be examinations at the end of each semester as per the academic calendar of the University.

A candidate who does not pass the examination in any paper(s) shall be permitted to appear in such failed paper(s) in the subsequent examinations to be held in December/January or May/June. Those who fail in odd-semesters will appear in a subsequent examination of odd-semesters only. For example, if a student fails in a paper(s) in the 1st semester, s/he can appear in 3rd or 5th semester examinations only. The same applies to even-semesters. After the declaration of the result of the sixth semester examinations, special examinations will be conducted for clearing the backlog of 5th and 6th semesters.

A candidate should get enrolled/registered for the first semester examination. If enrollment/registration is not possible in the preceding semesters owing to shortage of attendance beyond condonation limit/ordinances prescribed OR belated joining OR on medical grounds, the candidates are not permitted to move to the next semester. Such candidates shall redo the semester in the following academic year as a regular student.

Student must have 75% of attendance in each course for appearing in the end Semester examination. A shortage of attendance upto 15% can be condoned by the Vice Chancellor as per Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna rules.

Passing of Examinations and Promotion Rules

A student will be promoted from second semester to the third semester and from fourth semester to the fifth semester if s/he has secured a minimum CGPA of 5.

Evaluation

Pattern of Evaluation of the End-semester examinations will be as per the rules of the University.

The performance of a student in each course is evaluated in terms of percentage of marks with a provision for conversion to grade points. Evaluation for each course shall be done by a continuous internal assessment (CIA) by the course teacher concerned as well as by an end semester examination and will be consolidated at the end of the course. The ratio of marks to be allotted to continuous internal assessment and to end semester examination is 40:60. The evaluation of practical work, wherever applicable, will also be based on continuous internal assessment and on an end-semester practical examination.

The details of the Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) should be worked out by the Institute and a copy should be given to the University. All the relevant records of the CIA should be preserved by the Institute till the student passes out.



The passing minimum for ESE & MSE Theory shall be 33% and CPA & ESE Practical shall be 45% separately. Failed candidates in the Internal Assessment are permitted to improve their Internal Assessment marks by writing a re-test or by submitting assignments as per the decision of the Institute/ Authority.

Awarding of Degree

Degree will be awarded to a student provided; s/he fulfils the following conditions:

A student passes in all examinations and thus earns the required number of credits.

S/he completes the requirement of spending 30 hours during the period of three years in involving herself/himself in social work in order to raise the social consciousness of the students and make a small contribution to society.

This could be in a village/NGO/Charitable Institutions or NSS or Adult Literacy Programme, etc. A declaration letter from the Institute regarding the completion of required number of hours to the University is a must.

Successful candidates shall be awarded the class/division at the end of sixth semester examination based on the aggregate of marks obtained in semester examinations consisting of 3000 marks.

The following is the categorization of successful candidates based on marks obtained by them

(a)	75% and above	First Class with Distinction
(b)	60% < 75%	First Class
(c)	Rest successful candidates	Second Class

Each successful candidate of all the six semester taken together shall receive a certificate in the prescribed format, specifying the subject in which he/she was examined and the class in which he/she was placed.

A candidate who is placed first in the first class in the subject shall be awarded Gold Medal.

Student shall be expected to complete the requirement for the award of BMFP in a minimum period of three consecutive years and a maximum period of four years from the date of admission. There shall be no relaxation in lower or upper time limit of the programme.

A student, who has secured less than 45% mark in any end semester evaluation (ESE) shall be allowed to appear only once for the improvement of marks.

The Vice-Chancellor may appoint a board of moderation to look into all the examination conduct and result shall be published by the examination board of Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna.



BMFP Admission Test 2024

Aryabhatta Knowledge University, Patna invites the application from eligible candidates for admission in the course of BACHEOR IN MITHILA FOLK PAINTING (BMFP).



University will hold Admission Test for selection of candidate. Selection for admission shall be made strictly in order of merit i.e. percentage of marks secured by the candidate at the Admission Test held for the purpose.

No Candidate will be permitted to appear in the Test without a valid Admit Card. The admit card should be presented to the invigilators/other authorised officials for verification. The candidate's identity will be verified in respect of his/her details on the Admit Card. If the identity is in doubt, the candidates may not be allowed to appear in the Test. The authorities may at their discretion provisionally permit the candidate to appear in the Test after completing formalities including taking of thumb impression/several signatures for further verification. No extra time will be granted for these formalities to be completed.

Admission and selection procedure

Admission shall be made strictly in order of merit, i.e. percentage of marks secured by the candidate in the Entrance Test and the preference of institutions filled by the candidates.

Reservation of seats provided in the general ordinance for admission will be applicable only when candidate fulfills the minimum requirement. The reservation policy of the State Government of Bihar (for educational institutions) and the University rules will be followed.

If at any stage it is found that candidate has furnished any false information, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately.

The university reserves the right to take final decision in all matters of admission.

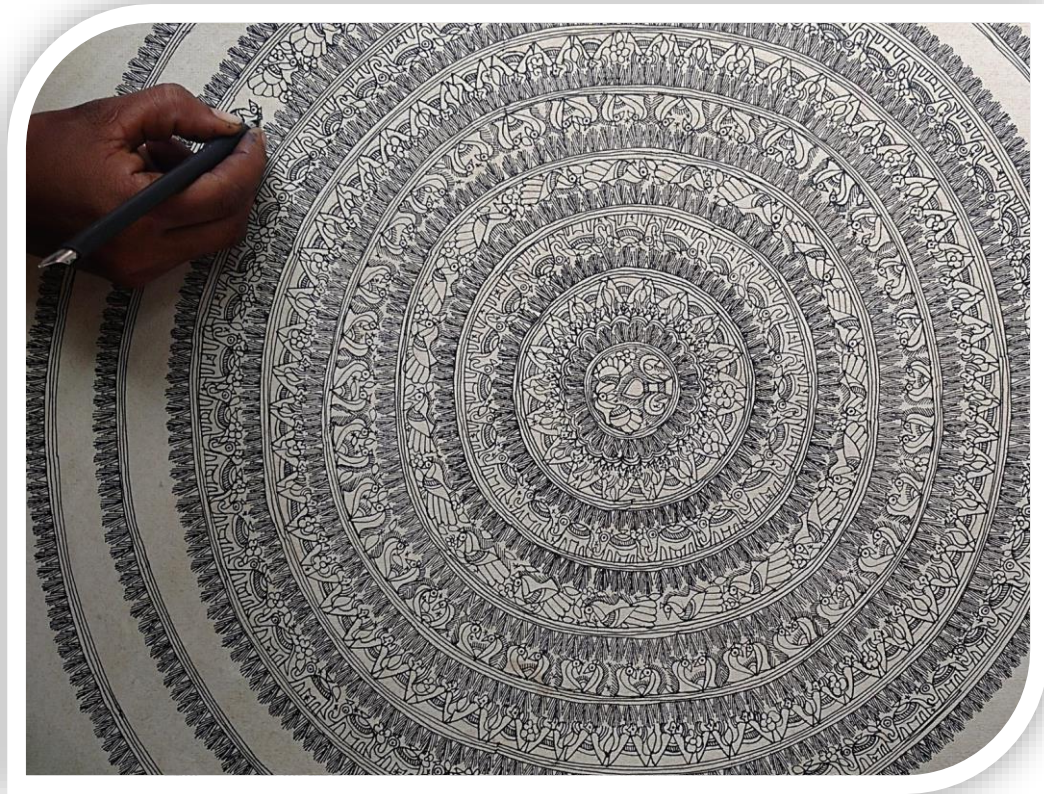
